



For countries where standard import regulations restrict importing refurbished products, **TempEx is the solution.**

TempEx services eliminate reliance on new inventory by allowing customers to temporarily export defective products for repair. After repair, the product is reimported to the originally exported country and placed back into inventory, creating:

Maximize Asset Value

Typically, there are two choices when replenishing inventory in countries restricting refurbished products:



The cost associated with buying new inventory and importing new parts is much higher than fees associated with temporarily exporting defective products and reimporting them as repaired.

TempEx allows you to maximize asset value by repairing defective products and reimporting them to service parts inventory, for future use.

Where is TempEx Available?

Every country has its own directives regarding the import of refurbished products. However, there's one consistent rule to the TempEx program – **there is a time limit to how long the part is allowed to be out of the originally exported country for repair before it must be reimported.** Managing that timeline is paramount.

Serviceable Countries for Flash Global's TempEx Services:



Argentina

Time Limit: 180-days to export, repair, and reimport

Benefit: Reduce expenditures by reimporting repaired products, compared to new imports



Brazil

Time Limit: 180-days to export, repair, and reimport

Benefit: Reduce cost by paying 80% customs value on repair value versus new inventory value



China

Time Limit: 180-days to export, repair, and reimport

Benefit: An economical alternative to China's New Unused Product Standard Import Regulation



India

Time Limit: 180-days to export, repair, and reimport

Benefit: Cost effective substitute to India's New Manufactured Goods Import Regulation



Indonesia

Time Limit: 180-days to export, repair, and reimport

Benefit: Overcomes Indonesia's import restrictions related to refurbished goods imports



Turkey

Time Limit: 3-years to export, repair, and reimport

Benefit: Customs does not apply any import duties and taxes on reimported goods

Flash eliminates the pitfalls often associated with temporary exports, and significantly reduces time and resources you're required to invest in the process— allowing you to focus on what matters most – servicing your customers in the most cost-effective manner and growing your business.

How It Works



By creating a TempEx order in FlashTrac, an entire end-to-end, system driven process will take shape. Flash will send the part from the originally exported country to the appropriate Flash Global distribution center, and then to the repair vendor.

Meanwhile, Flash will monitor the timeline for reimport, and if necessary, file any appropriate extension paperwork on your behalf to avoid unnecessary penalties for non-compliance.

Upon repair completion, the repair vendor sends the parts back to Flash's distribution center, where they are shipped back to the originally exported country for reimport. Upon receipt at Flash's forward stocking location, parts will be placed back into inventory. **It is as simple as that.**
